OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

Professional Development

ASID Practitioner (Professional, allied, and associate) and Educator members must earn a minimum of 10 hours of approved continuing education every two years. The requirement may be pro-rated for new members joining midway through a reporting cycle.

This requirement is distinct from the continuing education requirements to maintain NCIDQ certification, through the Health Safety, and Welfare (SW) CEUs completed for NCIDQ certificate renewal will also fulfill ASID CEU requirements.

- Qualifying CEUs may be
- IDCEC approved
- Approved by State Regulatory Boards and self-reported to the IDCEC with ASID Approvale code 31200
- Approved by industry-relevant organizations (AIA, GBCI, IFMA, and NKBA) and selft reporte dto IDCEC with ASID approval code 31400


